

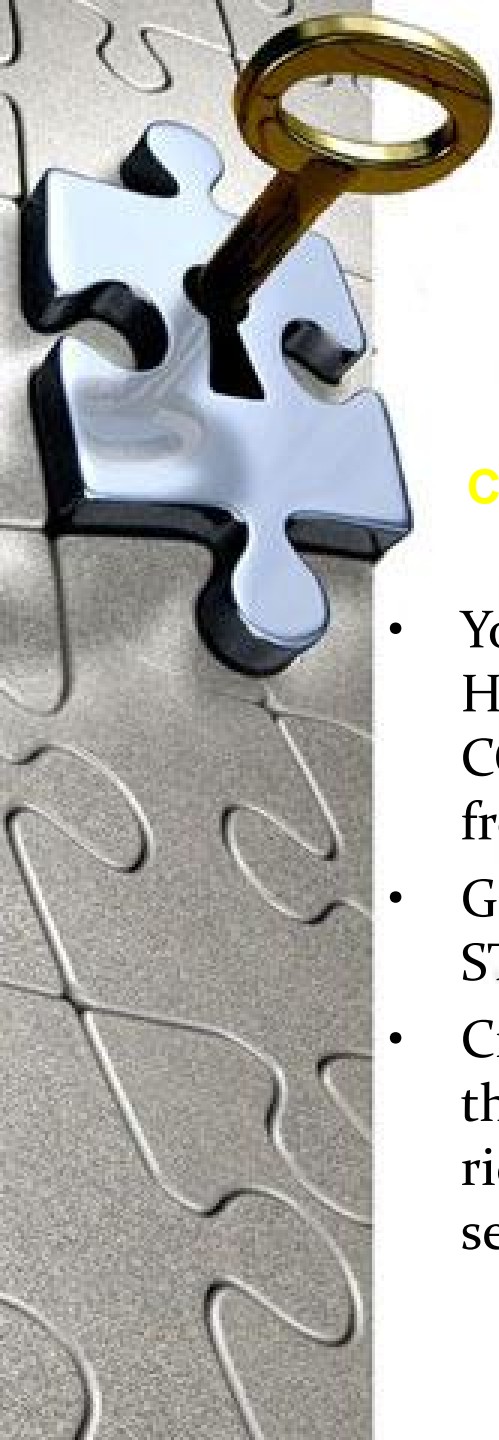


**Alternative energy

Crops or Wild horses

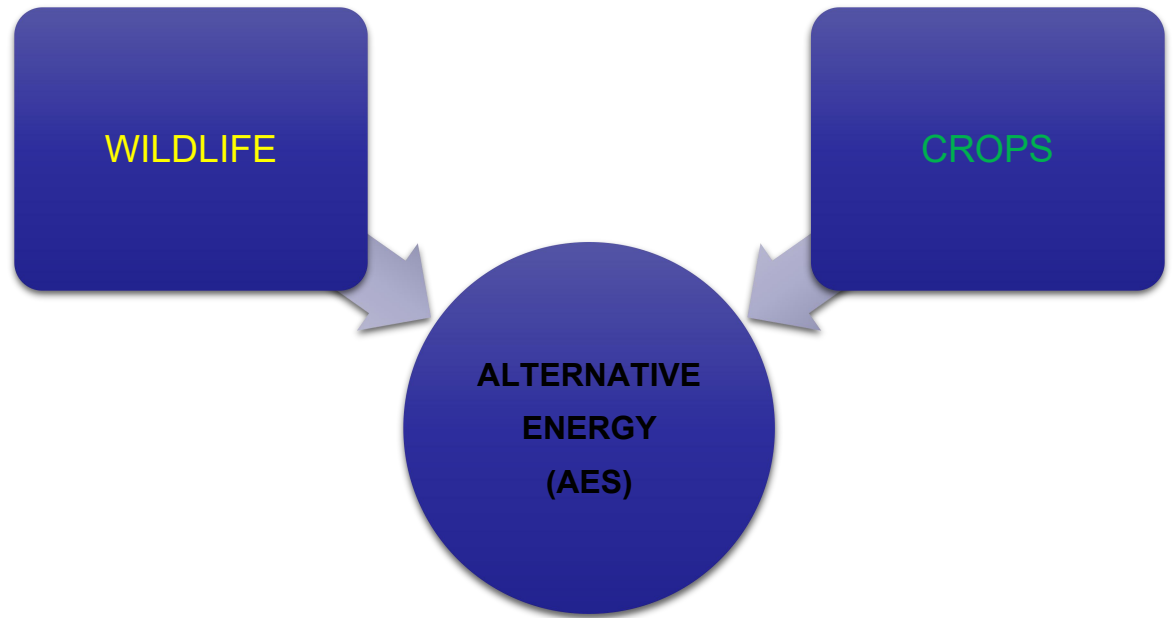
CROPS

- You can HARVEST/GATHER/ COLLECT the crops, from the FIELDS.
- Grains can be STORED for later use.
- Crop YIELDS refers to the amount of wheat, rice, etc produced in a season.

WILDLIFE

- You can CAPTURE wild horses, and HARNESS them.
- You can TRAP a fox.
